Committee Charge: *Charged with reviewing Issue Submissions as submitted to the committee. We are currently reviewing the follow issues:*

- Issue 2016-001 Defining Caterer in Cal Code
- Issue 2013-007 Temporary Dishwashing

Meeting Notes:

During this meeting, we had an initial discussion of Issue 2016-001 and we did not discuss Issue 2013-007. Shannon, member of Central County FTAC participated in the discussion. Below are some of the discussion points:

- Regulators approach to catering is inconsistent throughout California
- Perhaps too wordy, look at removing any redundant information or make referrals to other appropriate sections of Cal Code, as applicable. For example, by adding “Caterer” to the definition of a food facility, we can assume caterers would need to comply with certain requirements of a food facility, such as having a valid permit. We will look at other areas for redundancies
- Discussion was made on a local jurisdiction’s ability to prohibit any type of food facility, since some jurisdictions may have more restrictive local requirements already in place. It was pointed out that the wording in Section 113709 appears to allow local, more restrictive requirements:

This part does not prohibit a local governing body from adopting an evaluation or grading system for food facilities, from prohibiting any type of food facility, from adopting an employee health certification program, from regulating the provision of consumer toilet and handwashing facilities, or from adopting requirements for the public safety regulating the type of vending and the time, place, and manner of vending from vehicles upon a street pursuant to its authority under subdivision (b) of Section 22455 of the Vehicle Code, or from prohibiting the presence of pet dogs in outdoor dining areas of food facilities.

- Suggestion was made to utilize updated guidelines from CCDEH, in place of specific detail in the proposed language

We will discuss in further detail next meeting and begin to develop the language further.
